We appointed Hadyn Skinner as Senior KZN Mens Coach, Matthew Stringer as Ladies U18 Coach and Dyland Riddle as Boys U18 Coach.

We also appointed Zodumo Mzimela the Ladies U18 and Men's senior team Manager and Bulelani Mzimela the boys U18 Manager. Tanya Bower was appointed Chef the Mission at Junior Nationals.

#### **KZN Waterpolo continued...**

- 1. In 2021/22 KZN Waterpolo had 427 registered players/referees/officials an increase of 6,5%.
- 2. We had 161 Females and 266 Males registered
- 3. Out of the 427 players registered we had 16 African Black players, 16 Colored players and 9 Indian players.
- 4. We had 6 Ladies/Junior Ladies and 6 Men/Junior Men representing South Africa at tournaments.
- 5. We had 2 coaches and 3 referees attending international tournaments.

### KZN Waterpolo continued...

- 1. In 2021/22 KZN Waterpolo participated with a Men's team at Senior Nationals (Currie Cup) and we finished with a bronze medal.
- 2. In 2021/22 we had a Junior Ladies and Men's team at Junior Nationals and they finished 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> respectively.
- 3. Our KZN referees officiated at both these tournaments and numerous school tournaments
- Our Men's team participated in the inaugural Gauteng Invitational Tournament and placed 5<sup>th</sup> out of 12 teams that included professional teams from Portugal.
- 5. We regrettably did not have a Senior Ladies team in either Currie Cup or the Invitational tournaments which we will correct in the 2022/23 season.
