## **Prizes:**

- Medals will be awarded to the top 3 males and females in each age group.
- Awards to the overall top male and female in each age group.
- The above will be scored on the highest points achieved.

### **General Rules:**

- Gala will be swum in accordance with WORLD AQUATICS, SSA, KZNA and EDA Rules.
- One start rule applies.
- Beavers Swimming Club reserves the right to cancel or postpone the gala due to any unforeseen circumstances beyond their control.
- All results will be captured and recorded on the KZN and SSA database.
- The referee has the right to consolidate heats as deemed fit.
- The Referee has the right to change event sequence if conditions demand.
- The gala will be divided into four (4) sessions and officials must be submitted for each session.

#### **Protests:**

- Any protests / objections must be submitted in writing together with a fee of R500, up to 30 minutes after the event in question.
- The Referee and Tournament Committee decision will be final.

#### Officials:

- It is the responsibility of the club to ensure that all their officials report for duty.
- Official roster must be submitted with entries otherwise no entries will be accepted from that club.
- All technical officials to be correctly attired White top and navy-blue longs, shorts or skirts and predominantly white closed shoes.
- Officials are required to be qualified before the start date of the gala.
   Thereafter fines will be imposed.
- Unqualified Officials will not be allowed to Officiate at any Championship Gala or SSA Meet at any time.
- · Officials listed for duty at a gala and do not arrive will be fined

#### Fines:

- Unregistered/unqualified official R200.00
- No Show official at a gala R250.00
- Clubs that supply additional officials to cover a club with none or no-show officials will receive a portion of the fine levied as compensation.

#### Number of official required from clubs are as follows:

1-5 Swimmers	min of 1 Official per Session
6-10 Swimmers	min of 2 Officials per Session
11-20 Swimmers	min of 3 Officials per Session
21-30 Swimmers	min of 4 Officials per Session
30+ Swimmers	min of 5 Officials per Session
