- 1. Swimmers must be registered with KZN and SSA and on the latest database by 12<sup>th</sup> October 2025.
- 2. The Meet will run in accordance with KZNA, SSA and World Aquatics Age Group rules. The swimmers' age is determined by their age on the day of the meet. The one start rule will be in effect.
- 3. Scratching and No Shows after managers' meeting and/or without a doctors' note on the day of the gala, are subject to a R100.00 penalty fee per swimmer.
- 4. Late entries are permitted on condition the swimmer is already entered.
- 5. All entries to be submitted on Team Manager to <a href="mailto:recordsuda@gmail.com">recordsuda@gmail.com</a> along with pdf copies of entries, proof of payment, list of Officials and any Clearance Certificates required by 26th October 2025.

- 6. Each club MUST supply the required number of Officials as below. All Officials must be qualified and registered. A fine of R200 will be issued per unregistered/unqualified official.
  - All technical officials to be correctly attired White top and navy-blue longs, shorts or skirts and predominantly white closed shoes.
  - It is the responsibility of the CLUB to ensure that their required number of officials submitted report for duty.
  - CLUBS are accountable to find a replacement if a given official does not report for duty.

- Official duty roster must be submitted when entries are submitted. If officials are not submitted entries may be withdrawn.
- Officials are classified as Judges or Timekeepers.
- We acknowledge KZN's rules on clubs supplying officials for the gala. However, since
  we are a small district, those rules would not allow KCDA to host the gala
  professionally. Accordingly, we request that all participating clubs collaborate to
  ensure an adequate number of officials are provided for the successful execution of
  the meet. The allocation of officials from each club will be determined
  proportionally, based on the number of swimmers participating from each
  respective club.
- If a club doesn't supply the correct number of officials required KCDA will supply officials, and the club will be invoiced R250 per official.
- 7. **Entry Fee** R50 per event **Relay Entry Fee** R50

Late Entry fees R100 per event – subject to lane availability

8. Entry fees must be paid directly to clubs as applicable. Clubs to please make bulk payment to KCDA. Entries will be processed once full payment has been received. Entry fees are non-refundable, and no swapping of events are allowed.
