LATE ENTRIES

- R60 per event
- R50 admin levy if not already entered into the meet
- Submitted between 15-19 Sept:
 - Will be included in programme
 - To be submitted on email
 - To be submitted together with Proof of Payment
- Submitted on 20 Sept:
 - Will be subject to lane availability
 - To be submitted on a Late Entry form at the Meet Manager desk
 - For Session 1 received by 08h30
 - For Session 2 received by 11h30
 - Will be invoiced to the Club on completion of the Meet

OFFICIALS

- Each club MUST supply the required number of officials per session as per the KZNA Officials rules. Entries will not be captured without the completed officials roster to accompany them.
- A fine of R200 will be issued to the club for each unregistered or unqualified official placed on the pool deck for official duties .
- Should not enough clubs enter the meet to satisfy the officials requirement, clubs that have entered may need to provide additional registered and qualified officials to fulfil the requirement in both sessions.
- Officials attire: White Tops, Navy Blue Longs/Shorts/Skirts & predominantly White Shoes

GATE TIMES & FEES

Spectator Gate Opens | 08h00

- Under 12 | R20 per session | R30 both sessions
- 13/Over | R30 per session | R50 both sessions
